Re: Effect of Ohio's Stay At Home Order on our Operations

On Sunday, March 22, 2020, the Director of the Ohio Department of Health executed a Stay At Home Order for the State of Ohio, which takes effect today, March 23, 2020 at 11:59PM.

Per Item 2 of the Order, while all non-essential businesses and operations are required to cease all activities "all Essential Businesses and Operations are encouraged to remain open."
